CALL TO ORDER- The Workshop Meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners was called to order by President Calvo at 7:00 PM.

CHIEF'S REPORT- Chief Reggie Wright stated that there were 28 calls in April 2020, all NFIRS have been submitted, and all apparatus are in service. He said that Training/Compliance Officer Jim Ogle was keeping tabs on upcoming classes. He said he had 2 new applicants for new membership would drop them to the Wayside firehouse tomorrow, and that both potential new members need physicals from Meridian.

DISCUSSION ON OFFICER STIPENDS- Chief Reggie Wright and Deputy Chief Kyle Williams gave their thoughts on previous proposal discussions on officer stipends.

For Chiefs: 20% per month of call volume, 30% per year end, January through November.

Captains, Lieutenants, and line officers, 15% per month of call volume. January through November.

Chief: \$2,500.00

Deputy Chief: \$2,000.00

Captains, Lieutenants: \$1,500.00

Line officers, Engineers: \$750.00

New SOP's need to state: One stipend per official capacity.

Attorney Braslow stated we can amend the previous Resolution in the Regular Meeting.
