

WORKSHOP MEETING

JULY 15, 2021

CALL TO ORDER- The Workshop Meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners was called to order by President Costa at 7:00 pm.

ANNOUNCEMENT- President Costa advised the Board that all requirements of The Open Public Meeting Act of Chapter 231, Public Law 1975, adequate notice of this meeting had been met by advertising in The Coaster and The Asbury Park Press, and by posting on the bulletin board in the Tinton Falls Borough Hall and placed on file with the Borough Clerk 48 hours prior to this meeting.

CHIEF'S REPORT- Chief Kyle Williams had submitted his monthly report. There were 57 calls in June 2021, and 330 calls year-to-date. All NFIRS have been submitted. He stated that 2-66 needs \$1,483.51 in repairs from East Coast Lighting. He would like approval to purchase additional Mercedes hose from NJ Fire Equipment Co. for 36-2-74 for approximately \$1700.00. Also looking for approval to send various members to advanced training. These will be addressed in Regular Meeting.

Chief Williams stated that 36-2-74 is almost ready to roll. Formal training will take place July 26th at 7 pm, after which it will then be put into service with the main fleet.

Discussion on what to do with 36-2-75. Needs approximately \$15,000.00 of work to bring it up to speed. Commissioner Costa stated we would need a list of what would be needed to outfit it since many items were taken off to put onto 36-2-74.
